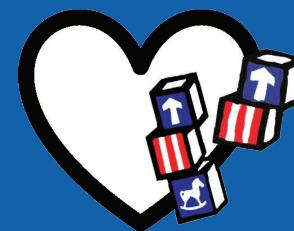

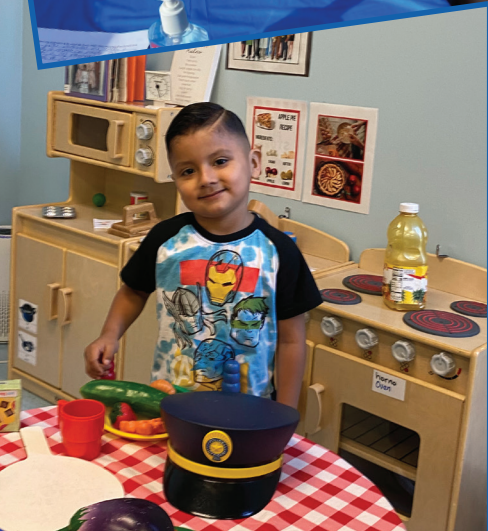

What We Do

Head Start provides free, comprehensive early childhood development and family services to low-income families living in Morris County. Programs offered include:

- Comprehensive family support services
- Referrals for free or low-cost medical, dental, and mental health screenings and care
- Parent education & family engagement activities
- Nutrition programs
- Parent and community involvement in program governance
- Afterschool child care and subsidy programs



Our Programs

Early Head Start

Services for expectant mothers and children up to age 3

- Home-based Program – For pregnant women and children from birth to 18 months
- Home Educators visit families' homes weekly
- Families receive two small-group socialization programs per month
- Center-based Program – For children 18 months to 3 years
- Full-day child development services September through July
- Research-based educational curriculum
- Teachers carry Child Development Associate (CDA) credential
- Bilingual staff
- Developmental, health and dental screenings
- Individualized programming serves children of all needs and abilities
- Home visits
- USDA-approved meals and snacks for children

Head Start

Services for children ages 3 to 5

- Center-based Program – High-quality preschool services
- Full-day school-year programs Monday-Friday
- Research-based educational curriculum
- Public school pre-k partnerships
- Teachers hold Bachelor's degrees and teaching assistants carry Child Development Associate (CDA) credential
- Bilingual staff
- Developmental, health and dental screening
